



John Ruskin School-Home to School Transport

On choosing a school that is not in your catchment area, it is the responsibility of parents and carers to pay for transport. For children who travel to John Ruskin School from Ulverston, Millom and Ambleside a private transport arrangement is procured by John Ruskin School. For Haverigg and Millom the transport is provided by Ricky's and for Ambleside and Ulverston Travellers' Choice.

The school charges parents/carers of students who live outside the catchment area a contribution towards the cost of home to school transport. Payments received from parents/carers are only a contribution towards the true cost of the transport, therefore it is very important your payments are received on time.

For the school year 2023/2024, the charge has yet to be decided but is anticipated to be £684 for the Millom, Ambleside and Ulverston bus. This can be paid either;

- ✓ in instalments of £57 by Standing Order as follows- first payment 1st September, second payment 10th September and then the 10th of every month with the last payment being July 10th.
- ✓ one payment of £684 within the first two weeks of September.

For students commencing Year 11, please note payments should continue up to July 2024.

The bus routes are detailed below-

- Ambleside Kelsick road 8.30am
- Ulverston the kiosk 8.10am
- Millom square 8.10am

It is your responsibility to arrange and pay as necessary for transport to and from John Ruskin School and not that of the school. You are making a commitment to purchase an **annual** bus pass. Transport charges are calculated on full occupation of a seat for the whole academic year. Reductions can not be made for absences due to illness, school trips etc.

Places for September must be pre booked by Friday 8th July 2023.

If you require a place on any of these routes in September, please fill in the booking form online.

When you complete the booking form you agree that once a place is allocated you are responsible for paying the transport fees for the full academic year (or remainder of the academic year if taking up a place part-way through the year).

Places can only be cancelled in exceptional circumstances, for example, moving house. You must contact the School Office in writing or email: admin@jrs.org.uk and return the pass immediately. Charges will accrue until we receive written notice of cancellation and the pass.
